## Members Report

- 1 Questions on treasure report need to review grants, need to review amounts on chocolate milk, terracotta cookies sales from Santa picture night & pizza orders breakdown waiting for reconciliation from Nada
- 2 Lunch lady school generated funds, estimated 30 40 orders per week and no volunteers needed. Mr. Clifford wanted to get school council approval before confirmed
- 3 Discussion on pizza provider for 2024. Pizza Nova is \$1200 more in profit for school due to HST savings. Karen has mentioned Gino's as an option from her other school. Denise to call

Gino's to get pricing and then school council members will vote on next Pizza provider for Jan to March. Confirmed price of \$3 for each pizza.

- 4 Discussion on having a member from student council to attend our meetings however Ms. Bahlis is the member from the student council to represent council at these meetings.
- 5 Santa pictures generated \$872, cost of Santa \$375- same number of pics as last year, 80.
- 6 Terracotta fundraiser sold 128 boxes, \$1073 \$706 profit. We were expecting better sales but will revisit for another time of year in 2025, perhaps Easter. Class who generated most sales will get a big cookie from this fundraiser.
- 7 Possible fundraisers from Denise for 2024 i) Laura Secord chocolates (\$150/case, \$5 a box), ii) World Finest Chocolates (\$90/case, \$3 a box) Denise to confirm on how the students would sell these
- 8 Discussed potential direct school donations from parents to school need to be specific on donation when raising funds. Mr. Clifford to confirm on how this could work. Parents to possibly donate tent for sports teams when attending events. If not tent will cost us around \$149.99.
- 9 Question to Mr. Clifford on chrome books when supply teacher attends, discussion on inventory on cables, school budget from Mr. Clifford takes care repairs, furniture, equipment, library resources, supplies, printing, photocopying, textbooks, software licenses.
- 10 Teacher lists Denise briefly walked us through the lists as they were just handed to her that day. We will approve the lists at the next council meeting.
- 11 Big budget items for approval organ and microphone, \$491.50. Council voted yes to approve so we can use during masses at school.
- 12.looking to possibly fund part of Muskoka trip for Gr 7/8 trip. Right now cost for trip is \$600 per student. Roughly 38 students confirmed for the trip so far.
- 13.Repeat X-movement for 2024 Would cost us \$2-\$3K we had balance with them last year therefore didn't have to pay.
- 14. Need funds for basketball nets, sport equipment, dances, x-movement or jungle gym for students, Scientists for classroom, boys night in to be added, Coach Miquel, buddy bunch.
- 15. Possible Spookathon for Easter raffles, donations Denise to confirm vendors, etc.
- 16.Genny to look into selling friendship bracelets for Valentines Day. Genny to come back with 3 vendors for approval to sell to students.

- 17. Christmas concert ask, if we could do next year since we have not done one since 2018 doing Christmas Family Night this year
- 18. Discussion on bus supervision for kids, need to clarify to kids and make sure teacher supervisor on duty directs kids to go to the right of school and not left.
- 19. Can we showcase in school good works that students do outside of school
- 20. Need mailbox for parents to make suggestions on where funds should go from school and any other suggestions they may have towards school.
