Members Report

1 – Fun Day –June 20th - The company Main Event (approved by the board) will be providing us with inflatables (approx 5 inflatables of varying sizes. One being a large obstacle course). The cost of the inflatables including a generator and a staff member is approx \$2137.40 including tax. This Friday Denise met with the main event coordinator sept who did a site inspection of the grounds. She also measured the gym and stated that should June 20th be a rain day, we could possibly fit all the inflatables in the gym. Failing which we have one year to book an alternate date.

We also plan to put out the games that were ordered previously by council (Denise will be opening the boxes and looking at the games with Nada this Thursday morning). For food we are offering a slice of pizza (choice of either pepperoni or cheese). 1 freezie (

Freezies are being donated by Kisko) and a small bag of chips (cost is \$13.99 for 36 bags to be purchased at Costco) for each child.

Parents will be sent order forms to decide and consent to their child being given any or all of the above and to select the choice of pizza slice. We are going to advise parents to supplement their child's lunch should they want to on that day. The Big games purchased will be available to be used for Fun Day. Volunteers confirmed Catherine, Denise, Paulina, Joanna, Cristy, Jaime, Sandra and Joyce.

- 2. Pizza I would like to let everyone know that prior to selecting Pizza Nova , Paulina bought (with her own funds) a box of pizza from pizza Nova and we physically measured both pizza's and found that they were the same size . The cost savings from pizza Nova is approx \$1100 per block and total cost for the year would be approx \$2300. We are however going to resend the survey to get parents a chance to give their opinion on what co they prefer. Although the cost savings are a lot with Pizza Nova, it makes no difference to us on which company we use but just a reminder that school generated funds (funds raised by the school is minimal) and hence school council needs to raise as much money as we can to cover various school items. We will ultimately defer to the company that the majority of parents decide. Discussed to move up start date from LY for Sept 2023 to increase pizza funds.
- 3. Teachers lists we have additionally approved approx \$1500 for new books for Mrs Mancini's class and \$1500 for Mrs Jenkins class. The reading level books were really outdated. An additional \$300 was required for sports uniforms and \$550 to Mrs Medeiros class for supplies. We are also covering \$700 for girls night in .

 Help We are in need of volunteers for fun day from 9 am 2 pm. If you know any other parent

that would like to volunteer, could you please ask them if they could help on that day.

- 4. There will be a end of year note to parents letting them know breakdown of funds raised for the year by the school council and how it was spent. It will also be outlined to them how the savings from switching from Pizza Pizza to Pizza Nova has assisted school in providing funding to the classrooms.
- 5. Discussed with Mr. Clifford that more school generated funds need to be raised
- 6. Spookathon for October 2023 discussed. Denise to bring in forms and vendors to hand out at next meeting, June 7th— event will be smaller than last year but will focus on less vendors but bigger prizes to generate more funds for school.
- 7. Denise to attend Journey into Learning for new JK Families to discuss with parents the importance of school council and to get new parents to join council.
